The receipt of all complaints will be acknowledged. Stakeholders will be informed of the complaint proceedure and and an initial response will be sent to the complaintant within two weeks. Complaints related to risk designations will be forwarded to the responsible body indicated in appropriate NRA. Upon receipt of a complaint a preliminary assessment will be conducted to determine whether or not the evidence provided is substantial. This will be done by determining if the evidence provided shows a risk of using material from an unacceptable source. A dialog with complaintants will be started to solve complaints deemed substantial before further actions are taken. Complaints deemed substantial will be forwarded to the certification body and the relevant FSC National Office for the supply area within two
