\* SBP certification requires conformance to Standard 2: "Verification of SBP-compliant Feedstock" in order to ensure that woody fuel used during the drying process of biomass meets the requirements for SBP-compliant or Controlled feedstock. The first step in this process is to define the Supply Base (SB) for all feedstock which is used in the production of SBP-compliant biomass. (The SB is defined as the area encompassing all places wherefrom feedstock is harvested (i.e. the location of the tree stump)). Once the SB is defined, then the next step is to determine if a Supply Base Evaluation (SBE) is required. Feedstock which is received with any of the following SBP-approved claims may be excluded from a SBE:

1. **Forest Management (FM) scheme claim (including partial claims);**
2. **Chain of Custody (CoC) system claim;**
3. **Controlled Feedstock (e.g. FSC Controlled Wood) system claim (Only for SBP Controlled Claims);**
4. **Recycled claim**

In addition, feedstock sourced within the scope of the certificate-holder's own SBP-approved CoC or Controlled system (e.g. non-certified reclaimed feedstock sourced in compliance with FSC-STD-40-007; non-certified feedstock source in compliance with FSC-STD-40-005), and post-consumer tertiary feedstock sourced following the requirements of Instruction Note 4A, SBP tertiary feedstock requirements, may also be excluded from a SBE. In all other circumstances, a SBE shall be completed.
