Night Work

- Poses additional hazards
- Illumination requirements
- Cal OSHA, possible night standard:
 - creating a minimum 10-foot—candle brightness requirement
 - requiring reflective clothing for workers
 - developing a written safety plan in place for night work
 - establishing a traffic plan for mobile equipment
 - designating safe areas for starting, stopping and rest breaks
 - establishing a system for accounting for workers
 - lighting and marking of water hazards









Emergency Plans



- Under 3220: a plan is required, with the following elements:
 - Procedures for emergency evacuation
 - Procedures for accounting for all employees
 - How to report emergencies, and more
- Evacuation-Training
 - The employer shall establish in the emergency action plan the types of evacuation to be used in emergency circumstances.







Temporary Agricultural Workers: H2A Program



- The H2A program allows U.S. employers or U.S. agents who meet specific regulatory requirements to bring foreign nationals to the United States to fill temporary agricultural jobs.
- Additional responsibilities: paperwork, written disclosures, transportation, and housing.



Recreational Marijuana

- California voted in favor of SB 94, the recreational marijuana initiative that allows adults 21 and over to possess up to an ounce of marijuana and cultivate up to six plants indoors.
- Employers may still enforce drug-free workplace rules for cannabis even with marijuana legalization in California. Companies can still drug test you for pot and fire you or refuse to offer you employment if you test positive.
- California's Supreme Court has held that an employer may refuse to hire an applicant who tests positive for marijuana, even if the drug is legally prescribed for a disability.

AB 1008

"Ban the Box," bill

AB 168

Prohibits questions about an applicant's salary history.

SB 63

 The New Parent Leave Act expands the current California Family Rights Act benefits to smaller employers.

• SB 396

 Expands sexual harassment prevention training requirements to include a discussion of gender identity and expression as well as sexual orientation.



And more ...



AB 450

 The Immigration Worker Protection Act prohibits employers from voluntarily agreeing to allow Immigrations and Customs Enforcement (ICE) agents to enter non-public areas of a workplace or accessing employment records without a warrant, subpoena or court order.

• SB 306

 Authorizes the Division of Labor Standards Enforcement (DLSE) to investigate an employer when retaliation or discrimination is suspected, with or without a filed complaint.

SB295

 Requires farm labor contractors (FLCs) to provide sexual harassment prevention and reporting training to employees in a language they can understand, and provide the DLSE with the number of persons trained along with a list of training material used.
